1. Publication

This tender follows the publication of the contract notice in the Official Journal of the European Union Nr OJ S 134

2. SUBMISSION OF THE BIDS

Bids must be drawn up in one of the official languages of the European Union. Each bid must contain one original and 2 copies.

Tenderers may submit offers:

The department is open from 08.00 to 16.00 Monday to Friday. It is closed on Saturdays, Sundays and Commission holidays.

Tenders must be submitted in a sealed envelope itself enclosed within a second sealed envelope, addressed as indicated under (a) or (b) above. The inner envelope must bear, in addition to the address under (a), the words, "Appel d'offres EAC/22/2012 – A ne pas ouvrir par le service du courrier. Invitation to tender EAC/22/2012 – Not to be opened by the mail service." If self-adhesive envelopes are used, they must be sealed with adhesive tape and the sender must sign across that tape.

3. OPENING OF THE BIDS

A committee will be set up to open the tenders and to check whether the procedures for the submission of tenders have been complied with. This committee will open the tenders on 10/09/2012 at 11am in DG EAC's meeting room 10/077, Tour Madou, 1 place Madou, B-1210 Saint-Josse-Ten-Noode

A representative of each Tenderer may attend the opening of the bids.

4. TENDERS

Tenders must be:

- (1) drawn up preferably on the Tenderer's headed paper;
- (2) perfectly legible in order to rule out any doubt whatsoever concerning the words or figures;
- (3) drawn up using the enclosed model reply forms (where applicable);
- (4) signed by the Tenderer or his duly authorised representative.

5. DOCUMENTS TO BE PROVIDED BY THE TENDERER:

- (1) Annex 3 including the forms referred to therein, as set out in point 1 of the Tender Specifications accompanied by the supporting documents described in these forms;
- (2) The declaration on honour with respect to the Exclusion Criteria and absence of conflict of interest (Annex 4), as set out in point 4 of the Tender Specifications;
- (3) The documents required for the appraisal of Tenders on the basis of the Selection Criteria set out in point 5 of the Tender Specifications;
- (4) The documents required for the appraisal of Tenders on the basis of the Award Criteria set out in point 6 of the Tender Specifications;
- (5) The completed form in Annex 5, giving the price, in accordance with point 7 of the Terms of Reference.

6. ACCEPTANCE OF CONDITIONS

Submission of a tender entails:

- (6) acceptance by the Tenderer of all the terms and conditions stipulated in this Invitation to Tender, in the Specifications, and all the Annexes thereto, including the draft Contract. This submission binds the Tenderer to whom the contract is awarded, for the duration of the contract.
- (7) Where appropriate, waiver of the Tenderer's own general or specific terms and conditions.

7. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

Tenderers must keep their bids open, in respect of all the conditions therein, for a period of nine months after the deadline for the submission of bids. The conditions set out in the Tenderer's bid may not be varied in any respect during that period.

8. CONTACT BETWEEN THE CONTRACTING AUTHORITY AND THE TENDERERS

Tenderers will be informed of the outcome of their offers, which is expected to be known by October 2012.

Contacts between the Contracting Authority and Tenderers are prohibited throughout the procedure save in exceptional circumstances and under the following conditions only:

- Before the final date for submission of tenders:
- * At the request of the Tenderers, the Contracting Authority may provide additional information solely for the purpose of clarifying the nature of the contract.

Requests for additional information received less than five working days before the final date for submission of tenders will not be processed.

- * The Commission may, on its own initiative, inform interested parties of any error, inaccuracy, omission or any other clerical error in the text of the call for tenders.

- After the opening of tenders
- * If clarification is required or if obvious clerical errors in the tender need to be corrected, the Contracting Authority may contact the Tenderer provided the terms of the tender are not modified as a result.
